# Dorothy Doll (pattern corrections)

#### Corrections by MakerKnit.com

Here are my corrections to the Dorothy doll pattern in "The Wizard of Oz Crochet" by Kristen Rask.

## Head

Rnd 3: stitch count should be (18) Rnds 4 – 7: stitch count should still be (18) Rnd 9: stitch count should be (12) Rnd 10: stitch count should be (9) Rnd 11: stitch count should be (6)

### Hair

Rnd 4: \*sc, sc, 2sc in next stitch; repeat from \* around (24) Rnds 5 – 7: stitch count should still be (24)

### TOP TORSO

Rnd 3: stitch count should be (18) Rnd 4: stitch count should still be (18) Rnd 5: stitch count should still be (18) Rnds 6 – 10: stitch count should still be (18)

### BOTTOM OF DRESS: BLUE AND WHITE YARN

Rnd 3: stitch count should be (18) Rnd 4: stitch count should be (24) Rnds 5 – 13: stitch count should still be (24)

If you want a solid blue band at the dress hem like shown in the book's photo of the completed doll, add Rnd 14: change to blue yarn only and sc in each stitch (24); then continue the pattern as written.

### BOTTOM OF DRESS: WHITE YARN

Rnd 3: stitch count should be (18) Rnd 4: stitch count should be (24)

### Arms

Rnd 5: sc2tog, sc2tog, sc in next 4 sts (6) Rnd 14: stitch count should be (6) Rnd 15: stitch count should be (4)

### Legs

I added one more round so my Dorothy's legs would be longer (I thought Dorothy's legs looked a little short and stumpy in the book's photo). If you want your doll to have longer legs also, add Rnd 10: sc in each stitch (5); continue pattern as written.
